In a letter submitted to the Morbi collector recently, the association expressed concerns and claimed that employees of the collector's office were favouring Oreva Group, which has been ordered to rehabilitate the victims and their kin.

Oreva Group was managing and maintaining the British-era suspension bridge in Morbi that collapsed in Oct 2022 killing 135 people. The company's chairman, Jaysukh Patel, was arrested along with nine others for negligence. All the accused are currently out on bail. The HC in its order dated Jan 30, instructed the Morbi district collector to form a team of 15 individuals, including medical officers, mamlatdars, municipality officials, child development officers, and others. This team had to visit the victims and gather information about their needs using a standardized format.

On Jan 29, Oreva company presented a proposal to the high court, offering to provide medical and financial assistance to the victims. The court's primary concern was to rehabilitate those who suffered permanent injuries, orphans, widows, and elderly people who lost their breadwinners, as well as to provide medical support to those dealing with mental trauma.

In March, a report detailing the victims' rehabilitation requirements was submitted to the court. The court, in its order dated whole-heartedly welcomed three-four years."


