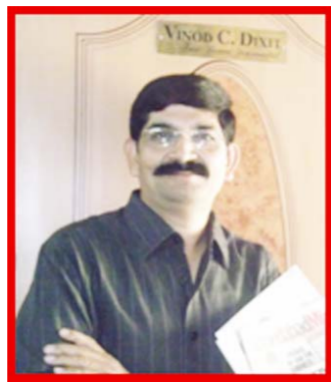


Our nation's safety is totally dependent on our soldiers - PM Modi

WR Transported 17.47 Million Tonnes Through 8513 Rakes Of Goods Trains

Ahmedabad, Despite complete lockdown imposed from 22nd March, 2020 and the current partial lockdown, Western Railway has done commendable work by loading 8513 rakes of goods trains till 7th July, 2020, including various essential commodities such as POL - 933, Fertilizers - 1330, Salt - 477, Foodgrain-90, Cement - 588, Coal - 334, Containers - 4191 & General Goods - 41 rakes, amounting to 17.47 Million Tonnes to different states of the country, including North East region. In addition to this 387 rakes of Millennium Parcel Van and Milk Tank Wagons containing various essential commodities such as medicine, medical kits, frozen food, milk powder and liquid milk were loaded to Northern & North East region. Total 16763 Freight trains were interchanged with other Railways including 8384 trains handed over and 8379 trains taken over at different interchange points of Western Railway. During the period, important inward rakes such as 1117 rakes of Jumbo, 601 rakes of BOXN and 487 rakes of BTPN were unloaded at various stations over Western

Rly, despite shortage of labourers. According to a press release issued by Western Rly, since 23rd March to 7th July, 2020, commodities weighing more than 72 thousand tonnes have been transported by Western Rly through its 385 parcel special trains, which mainly included agricultural produce, medicines, fish, milk etc. The earnings generated through this transportation, has been approxRs 23.16 crore. During this period, 54 milk special trains were run by Western Rly, with a load of more than 40 thousand tonnes and 100% utilization of the wagons, generating revenue of approxRs 6.99 crore. Similarly, 321 Covid-19 special parcel trains with a load of more than 27 thousand tonnes were also run to transport various essential commodities, for which the revenue earned was Rs 14 crore. In addition to this, 10 indented rakes carrying 4355 tonnes were also run with almost 100% utilization generating revenue of more than Rs 2.16 crore. WR has scheduled to run various timetabled Parcel special trains during lockdown



period to different parts of the country. Out of these, four Parcel Special trains, including a milk rake departed from various stations of WR viz. Bandra Terminus - Ludhiana, Porbandar - Shalimar, and Okha - Changsari and a special milk rake departed from Palanpur to Hind Terminal on 8th July, 2020.

The total loss of earnings over Western Railway on account of Corona Virus, has been over Rs 1635 crore, which includes Rs 238.89 crore for suburban section and Rs 1396.49 crore for non-suburban. In spite of this, resulting to cancellation of tickets since 1st March, 2020 till 7th July, 2020, Western

Railway has ensured to refund Rs. 387.15 crore. It's worth mentioning that in this refund amount, Mumbai division alone, has ensured refund of more than Rs 184.19 crore. Till now, 59.43 lakh passengers have cancelled their tickets over entire Western Railway & have received their refund amount accordingly.

Bhubaneswar: The East Coast Railway (ECOR) today decided to stop services of three intra-state special trains after receiving poor response from passengers. It has been decided to cancel services of three Express Special Trains with effect from July 10 till July 31, 2020, read the notification from

Priyanka Gandhi demands CBI probe in Vikas Dubey case



New Delhi: After the arrest of Vikas Dubey in Ujjain, the Congress has upped its ante on the Yogi Government, party General Secretary Priyanka Gandhi Vadra on Thursday demanded a CBI inquiry into the whole case. Priyanka Gandhi said in order to reveal the nexus between the criminal and the higher-ups, an inquiry by the CBI was necessary. In her tweets in Hindi Priyanka said, "After the heinous murders in Kanpur, the promptness with which the Uttar government should have acted, proved to be a total failure."

a three-month-old letter and the name of Vikas not being in the list of notorious criminals suggests that the connections are far-reaching. "The UP government should conduct a CBI inquiry into the matter and reveal all the facts and the protection-connections." According to the police, Vikas Dubey reached the temple at Ujjain around 8 a.m. and then informed the security men about his identity and asked them to inform the police. Dubey has been on the run for almost a week, ever since the ambush and killing of eight police personnel in Kanpur. As police searched for him in Haryana, Delhi, a close watch

was kept on the Indo-Nepal border. A photograph that has gone viral, shows Dubey sitting comfortably on a sofa inside the temple complex. Uttar Pradesh Police officially confirmed the arrest of Vikas Dubey. Madhya Pradesh Home minister Narottam Mishra tried to take the credit for the gangster's arrest. Speaking to the media minutes after Dubey was whisked away to an unidentified location for medical examination and questioning, Mishra said: "Hamari police kisi ko nahin chhodti hai. Hamare jaanbaaz police jawanon ne usey Dhar dabocha (Our police never lets any criminal go Scott free. They have nabbed him)."

Syllabus Reduction Likely In Odisha After Schools Re-open: Minister

Bhubaneswar: After the CBSE announced a reduction in syllabus for Class 10 to 12 by up to 30% for 2020-21 academic session owing to the circumstances caused by the Coronavirus pandemic, Odisha School and Mass Education Minister Samir Ranjan Das today said syllabus might also be curtailed in the State education boards. "The decision on opening of schools will be taken keeping in mind the Covid-19 situation in Odisha after August 31.

Syllabus might be curtailed by more than 30% if the situation demands. However, it can be ascertained only after schools re-open," said the Minister. Meanwhile, all the educational schools in Odisha have been closed down till August 31 in view of the rising cases of coronavirus in the State. As per the updated curriculum by the CBSE, among the chapters that were deleted from Class 10 syllabus are- democracy and diversity, gender, religion and caste, popular struggles and movement, challenges to democracy. Similarly, for Class 11, the deleted chapters included- federalism, citizenship, nationalism, secularism, growth of local governments in India. Among the portions that were omitted from Class 12 curriculum are on India's relations with its neighbours, changing nature of India's economic development, social movements in India and demonetisation, among others.

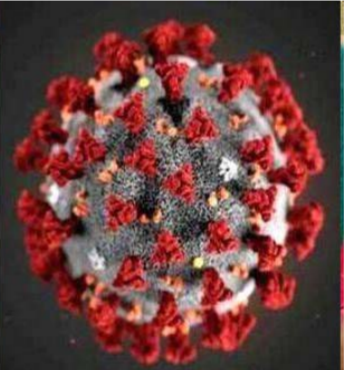
Namita to launch her own endeavor in ESG & Sustainable Finance

The plan was prepared following a directive from the chief minister. In areas like Poonthura where it reached a situation of super spread,

strict restrictions will be imposed by separating the area into special clusters. Testing will be increased in areas where there is a larger outbreak. Infected persons will be identified quickly and their contacts will be quarantined. A guideline was issued regarding this. A review meeting will be held every day and further measures will be taken. Aggressive awareness campaigning will be held in COVID hit areas, the minister said. In our neighbouring state of Tamil Nadu, the COVID outbreak is severe.
